Welcome to the new **Weirton Family Resource Center (WFRC)** where families really connect to their children, to other families and to the services they need to raise healthy, happy children! The **WFRC** is a safe, fun environment for all families in the community to receive training and materials on developmental topics and parenting skills, participate in parent-child activities, connect with other parents or peers with similar concerns, and receive information and referrals to other community agencies and services as needed.

The **WFRC** is open to all families in Hancock and Brooke counties with a focus on children aged from prenatal through college and/or employment. We want to provide families with the resources they need to help their children become independent, productive adults. We are available to **ALL** families regardless of income or any other eligibility requirements.

The **WFRC** is a “one-stop shop” information center for community resources and services. Families can access a variety of information and choose the programs which meet their specific needs. The Brooke Hancock Parents as Teachers program is housed in the **WFRC** and other collaborating agencies also provide programs there. Some of the direct services provided at the center are playgroups, support groups and after school tutoring and homework help.
