

REACHH-Family Resource Center

Our Family Resource Center will host weekly playgroups for caregivers and children up to age 4 and will also host Community Baby Showers. We will have a baby closet available for our families to receive diapers, food, and baby clothes as needed. A Community Resource Specialist will be housed at Summers County DHHR three days a week in order to provide information, resources, and referrals for DHHR staff and clients about community based services. The Family Matters program, an evidence-based program aimed at reducing the prevalence of tobacco and alcohol use will be implemented with middle school aged youth and their caregivers. A Truancy Diversion Specialist, which will be housed at Summers County Middle School, will implement a truancy diversion program as well as parenting classes. The Truancy Diversion Specialist will work with families to identify what is needed in order to address the underlying issues. We will also provide an After School Program for elementary school students.
