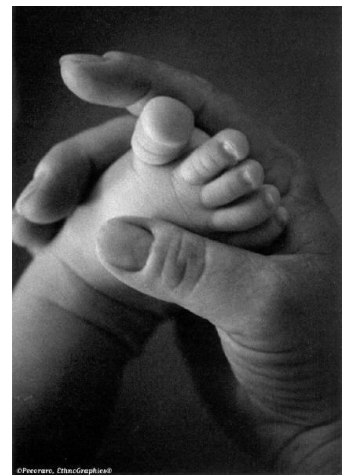


Birth to Three allows me to work around my family's needs while helping other families the way mine was helped. I can't imagine a more rewarding career!
