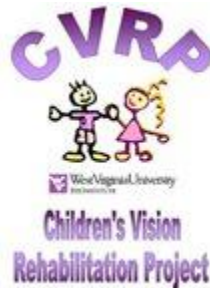




WV SenseAbilities
Serving children with combined vision and
hearing loss in West Virginia



PURPOSE: Children diagnosed with Cortical Visual Impairment or who have characteristics of CVI may be referred for selection to attend a clinic offered by the WV SenseAbilities Project and the WVU Children's Vision Rehabilitation Project. Children must be accompanied by a parent and at least one service provider so that information can be given to family and team member.

DATE AND TIME: **Monday**, April 9, 2012 Appointments and wait time will last approximately two hours. Referrals will be reviewed and twelve children will be selected. If your child is selected to have an appointment at that clinic, you will be given a specific time to arrive.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE: Any child in West Virginia with a diagnosis of Cortical Visual Impairment. Professionals or parents with children who exhibit characteristics associated with Cortical Visual Impairment, but do not have a diagnosis, can call Ruth Ann King to see if an appointment is appropriate.
