### **SPA 693: AAC Assessment and Intervention in the Schools**

The department of Speech Pathology & Audiology at West Virginia University in collaboration with the WV Department of Education is offering an online class for speech-language pathologists. Topics covered will include: AAC and the deaf/blind population, AAC for the beginning communicator, dedicated devices verses mobile technologies (iPad) and what's new in AAC.

### **Course Delivery:**

SPA 693 will be offered in the Spring of 2012. SPA 693 is a two-credit course and is totally web-based. This class includes on-line readings and activities, a course message board, and on-line real time chats. To access the course and participate, one must have an Internet server provider. Cable or high-speed access is preferred but not necessary as one can access by modem.

Course enrollment is limited. Tuition waivers are available. Begin the enrollment process as soon as possible since it does take some time to get through registration.
